

Starting from K.Achaia's Democracy Square, we follow the labels, which indicate that: If we go straight the road leads to Olympia and Pyrgos. If we go right, the road leads to Araxos Airport. We chose to go right, to Araxos Airport and to Kalogria terrific beaches...

We exit Kato Achaia, being very careful as we cross the rail lines. We soon see a label informing us that:

- If we go straight we will meet Alykes Village.
- If we turn left the road will lead us to Niforeika and Araxos.

Going towards this direction we pass through Niforeika, Kalamaki and Lakkopetra villages. The road is good and passes among cultivated fields. At 6.2 km the label shows us that if we turn right the road leads to Kalamaki beach. Similar labels indicate us the road we need to follow in order to reach beautiful Achaia's beaches, Such as Ionian Beach, Mayri Myti etc. If you travel during spring or summer months, remember to have your car windows closed, otherwise you won't avoid artificial rain, used for cultivations' watering. At 13.3 km we will see a label informing us that if we turn left, the road will lead us to Araxos Airport, which sub serves numerous charter flights, carrying tourists form all over the world.
